## **Eleventh Annual “For Pastels Only on Cape Cod” National Juried Exhibition to Include Work by Jeff Fioravanti**

Lynn, MA. July 22, 2006 – Artist Jeff Fioravanti is pleased to announce that his pastel painting “Winter’s Glow (Lynn Woods)” has been accepted into the 11<sup>th</sup> Annual “For Pastels Only on Cape Cod” National Juried Exhibition, sponsored by the Pastel Painter’s Society of Cape Cod and hosted by The Creative Arts Center of Chatham. The exhibit which features many of the top practicing pastel artists of today will be open to the public and on display at the Creative Arts Center, August 2–30, 2006, M–F, 9–4, Sat. 10–4, and Sun. 1–4.

Artist Jeff Fioravanti, who hails from Lynn, Massachusetts, continues to attract increased attention for his moving tributes to the American landscape. Recently featured in articles in the nationally distributed and respected American Artist magazine (Nov. 2005) and locally in The Daily Item of Lynn (June 2006), Fioravanti, through his strong use of color and intuitive feel for the passionate stories of the land, attempts to connect the people of our nation to the pristine beauty of America, and to help raise awareness of the loss we will all suffer should these natural landscapes and coastlines disappear in development and neglect.

A member of several well known art associations, he holds the added distinction of Signature Member in such nationally respected art groups as the Connecticut Pastel Society, the Pastel Painter’s Society of Cape Cod, and the Pastel Society of America of New York City.
