LynnArts “Works on Paper” Juried Exhibit to include Fioravanti’s “Twilight on the Confederacy”

Lynn, MA. (January 25, 2006) — Artist Jeff Fioravanti is pleased to announce that his original pastel painting, “Twilight on the Confederacy” has been accepted into the LynnArts “Works on Paper” Juried Exhibition, January 28 – March 3, 2006, with an opening reception scheduled for January 28th, from 2 – 4 PM. Located at 25 Exchange Street, in Lynn, Massachusetts, the exhibit, featuring some of the best local and regional artists will be available for viewing during normal exhibition hours of T,W,F,Sat. 11:00 AM – 4:00 PM, and Th, 11:00 AM – 7:00 PM. The exhibit is closed Sunday and Monday.

In William Faulkner’s “Intruder in the Dust” the author writes “for every southern boy...it’s still not two o’clock on that July afternoon in 1863...”

In Fioravanti’s accepted work, he offers an opportunity to reflect back to that time, that hour, that moment; to the spirit, the anxiety, and of the finality of that fateful day. Labeled as “very strong” by Juror Maureen Creegan Quinquis, Assistant professor of Art and Art Education Coordinator, at Salem State College, Jeff’s piece tells a story, not of war, but of peace; of the beginning of the end of one aspiring nation, and of the beginning of the restoration of another.

Lynn Arts Inc is a private, non-profit organization dedicated to promoting cultural activity in the city of Lynn, as well as to encouraging community interest and involvement in the arts in the Greater Boston area.
